



UFCW Minority Coalition Relative of Member Scholarship Program

Purpose:

To provide scholarship assistance to those related to a UFCW Minority Coalition member in good standing.

Eligibility:

The applicant must be a relative of a UFCWMC member in good standing. The member must be a member in good standing for a period of at least one year, and

Enrolled in an accredited, licensed or professional institution recognized as qualified to offer instruction in the academic areas pursued, or

A student in good standing in the college degree program or an applicant to the college degree program at the George Meany Center National Labor College.

Procedure:

The applicant must submit a completed **scholarship application**, an essay outlining how the applicant will further the goals of the labor movement as a student at their respective school (i.e. forming or participating in a student activist group that volunteers to help organize a workplace.) and official documentation confirming enrollment, course description and anticipated costs.

Awards:

Family members of eligible minority coalition members may receive an award up to \$750. There will be at least one award designated for a relative of a member in good standing.

Evaluation Guidelines:

Applications will be reviewed by three Executive Board members of the UFCWMC and one outside unaffiliated staff person of the UFCW.

For those attending the George Meany Center National Labor College, the application will be reviewed by a representative from the George Meany Center National Labor College, and the scholarship committee of the UFCWMC.

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of need and the scholarship committee's assessment of the applicant's personal statement.
